This autumn, in our Sunday morning and evening services, we're looking at what it means to be All Saints Peckham. God is calling us all, transforming us as his saints, and equipping us to live for him in Peckham and beyond. As part of this season, on Vision Sunday on September 30th, we'll be hearing some of the specific things we believe God is calling us to as a church, including our vision and plans for a church plant.

From mid-October onwards, in the morning, we hear how God's Word spoken centuries ago to the Old Testament prophets Jonah and Joel still speaks to us today.

In the evening service from Sunday 21 October we will be looking at the book of Daniel: vision for every age. The culture that surrounded Daniel felt far from the ways of YHWH. Questions whirled – who is really in charge here? Why be faithful when it seems to make no difference? Has God forgotten his promises? In this vision series, we'll lean into this book's practical advice as well as its visionary perspective, expectant that God will reveal himself to us today.
